

## ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- Baptised Catholic children living within the Parish of St Augustine's who have a sibling in the school at the time of admission
- Baptised Catholic children living within the Parish of St Augustine's
- Baptised Catholic children living outside the Parish of St Augustine's who have a sibling in the school at the time of admission
- Baptised Catholic children living outside the Parish of St Augustine's
- Non-Catholic children who have a sibling in the school at the time of admission
- Non-Catholic children
i. Children with a statement of special needs that names the school must be admitted. This will reduce the number of places available to applicants.
ii. Priority in each category will be given to children who are in the care of the local authority (Ref Sect 22 of the Children Act 1989).
iii. Sibling means brother, sister, half-brother/sister, step-brother/sister, adopted/foster children living in the same household as the applicant.
iv. If there is over subscription within a category, priority will be given to nursery children whose names were submitted earliest or by distance from the school for older children.
