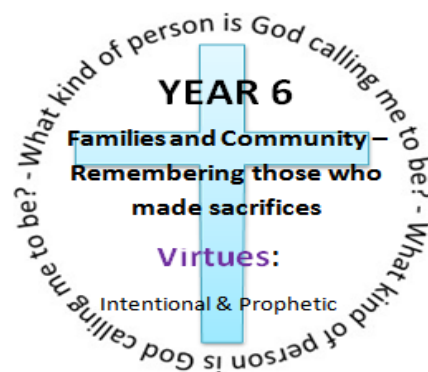
- To classify quadrilaterals using side/angle properties
