

## HELP TO KEEP OUR STREETS CLEAN AND SAFE

Many parents have alerted us to the amount of dog mess on the road and pavements near school.

Catching offenders can be difficult.

Any information you give to the council will be confidential.

## YOU CAN HELP BY ALERTING THE COUNCIL:

- Keep a note of the day and approximate times that the dog fouling is occurring.
   Many offences occur early morning or evening, but it's very useful if we know which.
- Write a description of the person in charge of the dog and the type of dog they were walking.
- Did they arrive in a vehicle if so what colour and type and is this a regular occurrence?

### REMEMBER ALSO:

CLEAR UP AFTER YOUR PET TO KEEP THE STREETS CLEAN AND SAFE.
