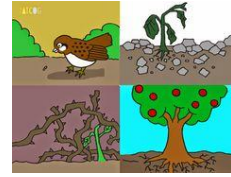

Be on time by 10 to 9.



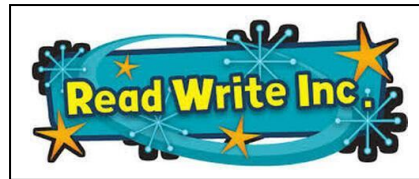
