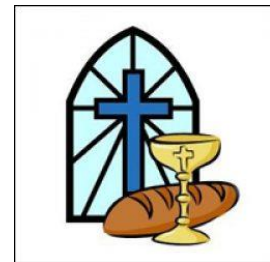
THIS WEEK'S NEWS

ATTENDANCE



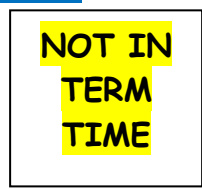
