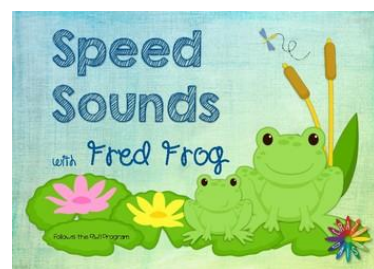
There are still some children who are regularly missing important parts of the school day because they are late.
