"NOURISH"

Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God, curing those who needed healing. In the late afternoon, the disciples said to him, "Send the people away to find food and lodging in the villages and farms. We are in a lonely place here." Jesus replied, "Give them something to eat yourselves."

The disciples answered, "We have no more than five loaves and two fish unless we go and buy food for all these people." There were about five thousand with them. Jesus told them to get the people to sit in groups of about fifty. Jesus took the five loaves and two fish then blessed and broke them, giving them to the disciples to share out with the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted. When the disciples collected the left over scraps, they filled twelve baskets.
