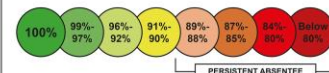

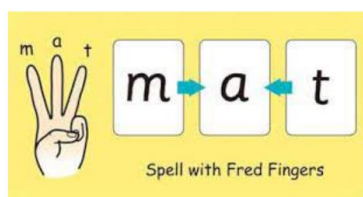
"Parents who are concerned about attendance should contact their child's school to tell them about the difficulties. Schools will try to assist parents by offering support or referring them to additional support services."
