"ADVENT"

At that time: Jesus said to his disciples: For as were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. We are delighted with the overall improvement this term. Children have benefited from being with us. Please note the following which should NOT prevent a child from attending school:

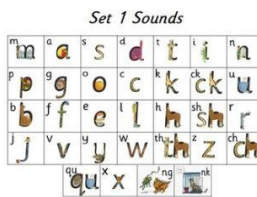
- headache/cold/a slight pain
