"PREPARATION"

In due course John the Baptist appeared; he preached in the wilderness of Judea and this was his message: "Repent, change your ways; for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand." This was the man the prophet Isaiah spoke of when he said, 'A voice cries in the wilderness: prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight'. This man John wore a garment made of camel-hair with a leather belt round his waist, and his food was locusts and wild honey. Please continue to monitor your children's use of social media very closely. This will help to avoid inappropriate conversations which can cause upset.



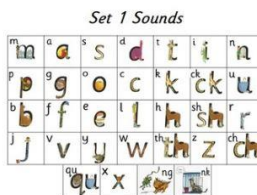
If any child has a cold, headache or slight pain, they should still be able to come to school. We shall contact you if the problem worsens and the child becomes too unwell to stay in school.
