

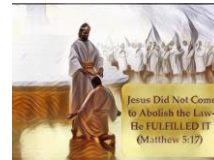

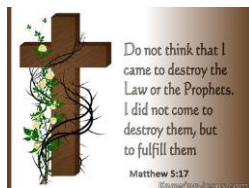
## Live, Love and Learn with Jesus *THE WEDNESDAY WORD*

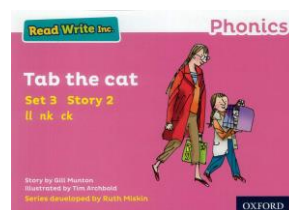


We need everyone on time for school every single day so you can all achieve your best.
