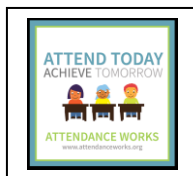

Follow safety guidance to keep cool and safe.

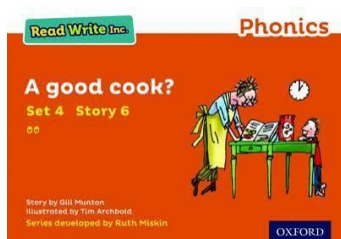
Keep the heat out during the day by closing blinds and windows.

Beat the Summer Heat

Stay Cool

Keep to air conditioned areas or find somewhere cool to go, like the pool

Stay hydrated

When in the heat, you should drink 24-32 ounces an hour, not exceeding 48 ounces in an hour

Seek shade

Try to stay in the shade, wear a brimmed hat, or use an umbrella to keep the shade with you

Wear light clothes

Try to wear lightweight and light-colored clothes to help contrast the sun's heat

No pets or kids left in cars

Hot cars can be deadly, never leave your pets or children in cars by themselves

Help others

Check in on others that may be more susceptible to the hotter temps
