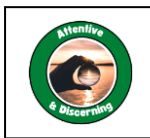
THE WEDNESDAY WORD

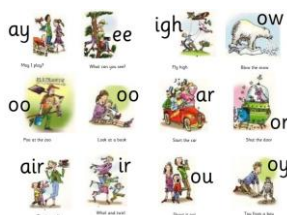
